## **ADVISORY**

### **No Tsunami Threat**

A strong distant earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of **7.3** occurred at **VANUATU** on **29 April 2016 at 03:33 AM** (Philippine Standard Time) located at **16.2°S, 167.7°E** with depth of **10 km**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
