## **ADVISORY No Tsunami Threat**

A strong distant earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of **7.7** occurred at **Southern Chile** on **25 December 2016 at 10:22 PM** (Philippine Standard Time) located at **43.3°S, 74.5 °W** with a depth of **15 km**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
