Cancellation of Sea-Level Change Monitoring

Earthquake in Chiapas Mexico at 12:49 PM (PST) on Friday, September 08, 2017

A great earthquake occurred **Off the Coast of Chiapas, Mexico** on **September 08, 2017** at **12:49PM Philippine Standard Time (PST)**, located at **14.9°N, 94.0°W** with depth of **33 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 8.2**. PHIVOLCS issued a **Tsunami Advisory** for all coastal communities along the Philippine fronting the Pacific Ocean where people were advised to wait and listen for updates as we monitor sea-level changes along the Pacific. No evacuation order was recommended. Sea-level gauges in Mexico recorded tsunami waves with maximum heights of 1.01 meters. The Pacific Tsunami Warning Center (PTWC) forecast tsunami waves less than 0.3 meters for the Philippines

Based on all available data, there is **no destructive tsunami threat** to the Philippines associated with this event.

This will be the final tsunami information issued for this event.

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
